COLONEL JOHN B. GURRIERI

Colonel John Gurrieri is the Commander 315 Operations Group Joint Base Charleston SC. He is responsible for the command of seven Squadrons, staff and equipment necessary to operate/deploy C-17A aircraft for worldwide contingencies on a daily basis. He leads over 500 personnel to train and maintain combat skills in flying, aeromedical evacuation, airlift control flight, life support, and survival training operations.

Colonel Gurrieri previously served as commander of the 317th Airlift Squadron. He separated from active duty and joined the Air Force Reserve in 2003, flying the C-17A Globemaster III with the 300th Airlift Squadron. A command pilot, he has logged thousands of flying hours in the T-37, T-38, C-141, and C-17 aircraft. He has worked two Joint assignments, one as the TRANSCOM Liaison Officer at Central Command (CENTCOM) and



Vance AFB, a Joint Pilot Training 3 year assignment. He is a current and qualified evaluator/instructor airdrop C-17 pilot. He holds a multiengine CFII.
