MAJCOM/LOCATION/SIZE: Air Force Reserve Command tenant unit at Joint Base Charleston, SC partnered with the 437th Airlift Wing and the 628th Air Base Wing, Air Mobility Command.

MAJOR UNIT/FORCE STRUCTURE:

- The 315th Airlift Wing is an Air Force Reserve C-17 wing with an airdrop, aeromedical evacuation, and combat camera mission.
